

Standard Wiring Dimensions for Distribution Boxes

Box Dimensions and Installation Heights Fixed distribution boxes are typically installed with the bottom edge 1.3–1.5 meters above the ground, while mobile boxes should be 0.6–1.5 meters above the ground. Enclosure materials are usually steel plates (1.5–3 mm thick depending on panel location) or insulating plates; wooden materials are not recommended. Single-gang boxes accommodate one device, double-gang for two, and multi-gang boxes for multiple devices, with sizes chosen based on the number of circuits and future expansion.

Spacing: The distance between a distribution box and a switch box should not exceed 30 meters, and the horizontal distance between a switch box and fixed equipment should not exceed 3 meters.

Wiring Specifications Use high-temperature resistant copper core wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load current. Ensure neat cable management, proper insulation, and clear wire identification to avoid exposed copper or confusion. Incoming and outgoing wire openings should have seals meeting Class 3 sealing requirements to prevent dust or moisture ingress. Power supply lines to high-voltage switchgear must not use plug connectors. Standard cable lengths for internal wiring are typically 1 m, 2 m, 3 m, 5 m, or 10 m, depending on layout.

Safety and Grounding All metal parts of the box, electrical boards, and appliances must be properly grounded, with the protective neutral wire connected via a terminal board. Each circuit should have its own breaker, fuse, or residual current device (RCD); RCDs should have a rated residual current ≤ 30 mA and operate within 0.1 s. Doors must be lockable, and no temporary equipment or sundries should be placed inside...
