- Main Breaker:** Preferably a 2-pole breaker to disconnect both line and neutral simultaneously for higher safety.
- Branch Breakers:** Connect individual circuits using single-pole breakers for lighting, outlets, or appliances.
- Neutral Bus:** Terminate all neutral conductors on the neutral bar.
- Ground Bus:** Connect all grounding conductors to the PE bar.
- Load Devices:** Connect outgoing circuits to the load terminals of branch breakers ().

Wiring Best Practices

- Line vs Load Identification:** Ensure supply conductors connect to LINE terminals and outgoing circuits to LOAD terminals.
- Wire Selection:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load current.
- Insulation and Routing:** Maintain proper insulation, neat cable management, and avoid exposed copper.
- Grounding:** All metal parts, including the box and internal components, must be reliably grounded.
- Protection Devices:** Include breakers, fuses, surge protectors, and leakage protectors for additional safety ().
- Labeling:** Clearly label all circuits for easy identification and future maintenance.
