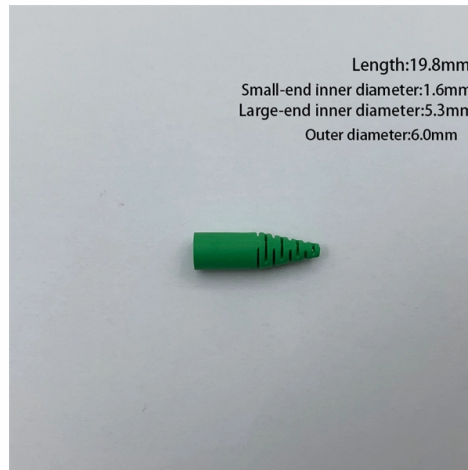


Standard for Level II Construction Site Electrical Distribution Boxes



AI Overview

Level II construction site distribution boxes must comply with three-level power distribution, robust material construction, proper protection devices, and separation of power and lighting circuits. Key Standards and Requirements

1. Compliance with Electrical Standards Construction site distribution boxes should follow AS/NZS 3012:2019 for electrical installations on construction and demolition sites, and AS/NZS 3000 Wiring Rules for general electrical installation requirements. These standards ensure safe design, construction, and in-service testing of electrical equipment on sites, including temporary switchboards and distribution boxes.
2. Three-Level Power Distribution A Level II distribution system typically implements three-level power distribution:
 - Main distribution box: Located near the power supply, equipped with a leakage protector (50–100 mA, >0.1 s) and short-circuit/overload protection.
 - Secondary distribution boxes: Installed near concentrated electrical equipment, with leakage protection ≤ 30 mA.
