Overcurrent Protection: Each temporary circuit must have overcurrent protection rated appropriately for the wire size and load. Distribution boxes should include a disconnecting switch or plug connector to allow all ungrounded conductors to be disconnected safely. Wiring Methods: Feeders and branch circuits can be run as multiconductor cords, cable assemblies, inside raceways, or open conductors on insulators. Open conductors are only allowed where they are not subject to physical damage, and overhead conductors must maintain minimum vertical clearances depending on what passes underneath. Mechanical Protection and Positioning: Temporary wiring should avoid crossing roadways or areas with heavy machinery. If unavoidable, protective measures such as insulated flagged catenary wires must be...
