Connector Compatibility: Supports multiple connector types (SC, LC, MPO) to match network infrastructure and high-density requirements. Accessibility: Front-access panels allow technicians to perform patching and maintenance without disrupting other connections. Integration with PON Architecture Triple-play services often use Passive Optical Networks (PONs), where a single fiber from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) is split to serve multiple Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at customer premises.
