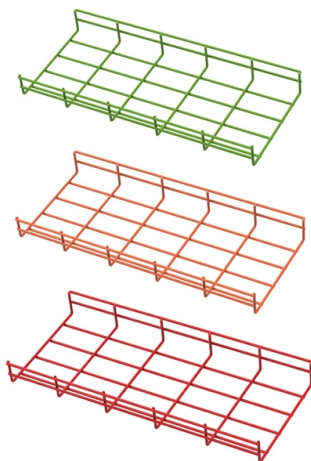


Switch connected to two fiber optic cables

The recommended approach is to configure the two fiber links as a Layer 2 EtherChannel (port channel). This allows both links to operate as a single logical connection, providing failover if one fiber link fails, without creating loops. Network Topology Considerations Star topology: Each switch connects directly to a central core switch. This is simple and high-performing for a limited number of switches, and fiber can handle high bandwidth. Ring or daisy chain topology: Less common today due to potential disruptions if one switch fails. Redundancy can be achieved with multiple fiber runs and EtherChannel. Practical Steps Install SFP modules in the switch ports corresponding to the fiber connections. Use compatible fiber patch cables (matching single-mode or multi-mode type). Connect the two fiber cables to the switch ports. Configure EtherChannel on the switch to combine the two ports into a single logical link for redundancy. Verify link status and ensure no loops exist in the network. By following these steps, the switch can maintain connectivity even if one fiber link fails, while avoiding network loops and optimizing bandwidth.
