

The function of optical cable manholes



Overview

A handhole is a small, underground utility vault or access point designed to allow maintenance personnel to access buried infrastructure like fiber optic cables, electrical conduits, or telecommunications lines. Handhole & Manhole in Fiber Optic Networks Fiber optic networks form the backbone of modern telecommunication systems, enabling high-speed data transmission across long distances. To protect these cables and allow easy maintenance, underground access chambers are used — primarily known as Handholes. A telecommunication manhole is a purpose-built underground chamber that provides a secure, accessible, and environmentally protected space for managing telecommunication infrastructure. The structure has a cover on the surface and a vertical shaft that goes down to the pipes or cables below. Most access points use a metal or concrete cover that is level with the road surface. Unlike heavy concrete or metal vaults used in other industries, today's composite telecom manhole chambers are lightweight.
