This ensures safety by reducing the risk of electric shock and ensuring proper grounding in hazardous situations. The general rule requires connecting the grounding terminal of a grounding-type receptacle and a metal box joined to an equipment grounding conductor employing an equipment bonding jumper sized per Table 250. Figure 1 shows how this general rule works. Grounding and bonding limit overvoltages, stabilize the voltage to the ground during regular functioning, and ease the proper operation of circuit breakers and fuses. All grounding and bonding work must comply with NEC Article 250.

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
