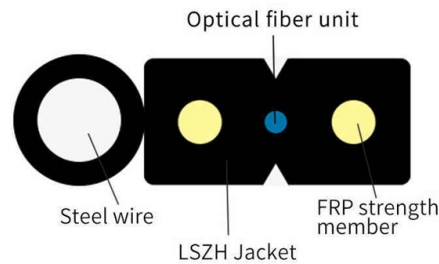


The leakage current switch in the distribution box tripped
