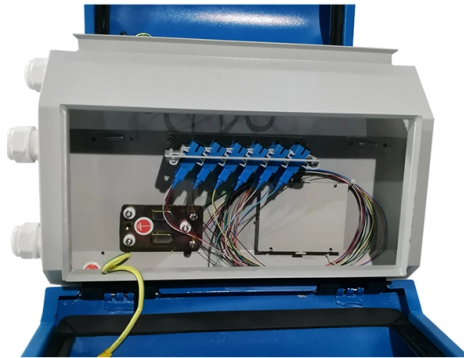


The router's fiber optic cable has been unplugged

Step 4: Verify Connection Lights After reconnecting, check the router and ONT lights. A solid green light on the "Power" and "Optical" indicators usually signifies a proper connection. A red or blinking light may indicate a fiber issue, requiring further troubleshooting or a service call.

Step 5: Test Network Functionality Once the cable is reconnected and lights indicate normal operation, test your internet connection on a computer or mobile device. If the connection is still not working, try restarting the router and ONT, or temporarily using a different Ethernet cable from the ONT to the router to rule out port or cable issues.

Step 6: Seek Professional Assistance if Needed If the fiber cable is intact, properly connected, and the lights are correct but the internet still does not work, contact your ISP or a service technician. They can test the line, replace faulty...
