

Thermal relay protection phase failure function

The thermal protection relay protects motors against prolonged overloads and, depending on the model, phase loss or phase imbalance. It is inserted into the power circuit but acts solely on the contactor control circuit to trigger motor shutdown. A phase failure (or) phase loss happens when the voltage in one (or) more of electrical phases reaches (or) approaches zero. What is a Phase Failure Relay?
