

Tips for bending cables at the top of distribution boxes



Overview

When cables are bent it is important that there is no undue strain on the internal conductors caused when the bend is too tight (522). For more information about bending conduit, see our Conduit EMT Bender Guide. Avoid twisting or kinking a cable during. These are the ten Article 312 and Article 314 items we deem most important, based on the pervasiveness of confusion and the potential costs of same. You must repair any non-combustible surfaces that are broken or incomplete so there's a maximum 1/4 inch gap at the edge of a cabinet or cutout box. Whether you are working with power cables, control cables, or data cables, understanding the bending radius is essential for safety, reliability, and compliance with standards. That means running wire or cable along poles, up walls, across cable.
