Traffic Splitters Traffic splitters are used to divide traffic into multiple paths. In networking, this can refer to optical splitters in Passive Optical Networks (PONs), where a single optical signal is split into multiple outputs to serve multiple customers. The split ratio determines how the signal power is divided, commonly in powers of 2 (e.g., 1x2, 1x4, 1x32), and can be centralized (in a central office) or distributed (in field closures or pedestals). In web applications, traffic splitters are used for A/B testing, where website visitors are divided into groups to test different versions of a site. Methods include randomization and stratification, ensuring statistically valid comparisons of performance metrics.
