

## Unlevel distribution box

- Wet spots or standing water in certain areas of the yard.
- Dry or underused trenches in the drain field.
- Slow indoor drains or foul odors near the drain field.
- Localized soil saturation, which can accelerate drain field failure.

**Testing and Maintenance**

To check a D-box:

- Locate the box using property blueprints or probing the ground along the septic tank outlet line.
- Open the lid safely and observe effluent flow into each outlet pipe.
- Use a level tool across the box to detect tilting or uneven alignment.
- Inspect for blockages or sludge buildup and clean as necessary.

Regular inspection and cleaning help prevent uneven distribution and extend the life of the drain field.

**Repair and Solutions**

Depending on the severity, solutions include:

- Cleaning and clearing blockages (\$200-\$500).
- Re-leveling the box to restore proper flow.
- Full replacement if the box is cracked or extensively damaged (\$600-\$2,000).
