Rung Spacing: Closer rung spacing increases material usage and weight. Typical spacing ranges from 150 mm to 300 mm for aluminum and steel trays.

Cable Load: The total weight per meter includes both the tray and the installed cables. Average cable loads can add up to 75 kg/m for heavily loaded installations.

Standards and Compliance

Ladder trays are designed according to IEC 61537 and NEC/CSA standards, which specify safe working loads, maximum deflection, and span support requirements.

Manufacturers provide Safe Working Load (SWL) tables or diagrams to ensure the tray can support both its own weight and the cable load over the intended span.

- Tray weight per meter plus cable weight
- Maximum span between supports
