What is PoE?

PoE switches (Type 1) comply with the IEEE 802.3af. The Power over Ethernet (PoE) is a widely used LAN technology that provides DC power to endpoints over existing copper Ethernet cabling used for data connectivity. Power is passed from Power Sourcing Equipment (PSE) over the twisted pairs to Powered Devices (PD) such as IP phones, IP cameras, card. In this configuration, an Ethernet connection includes Power over Ethernet (PoE) (gray cable looping below), and a PoE splitter provides a separate data cable (gray, looping above) and power cable (black, also looping above) for a wireless access point. This eliminates the need for separate power adapters, reducing cable clutter and. PoE switch refers to an application of PoE technology.

Standards-based Power over Ethernet is implemented following the specifications in IEEE 802.3af-2003 (which was later incorporated as Clause 33 into IEEE 802.3-2005) or the 2009 update, IEEE 802.3at. The standards require Category 5 cable or better for high power levels but allow using Category 3 cable if less power is required. In multi-pair cases, PoE supplies power as a common-mode signal over two or more of the differential pairs

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
