A passive copper cable does not contain any chips or ICs on the circuit boards on either end and therefore does not perform any signal processing during data transmission. AOCs are built for high-performance applications and are capable of supporting 800G speeds, making them ideal for modern. In simple terms, an active optical cable has modules at either end of an optical fiber cable that allows direct communication between devices over that permanently attached fiber cable. They eliminate the need for separate optical transceivers and patch cords, offering plug-and-play simplicity, zero power consumption (passive models), and ultra-low latency for connections. An Active Optical Cable (AOC) is an integrated optical transceiver assembly that uses fiber optics to transmit high-speed data over longer distances than passive copper cables. The term "active" signifies that electrical components are used to boost and convert the signal along the way.
