Check for ISP Outages: Visit your ISP's website or social media pages to confirm if there is a known service disruption.

Inspect the Fiber Cable: Look for visible damage, kinks, or tight coils. Ensure the cable is properly connected to the WAN/ONT port.

Reboot the Router and ONT: Power cycle both devices by unplugging them for about a minute, then reconnecting the ONT first, followed by the router.

Verify Connections: Make sure all connectors are clean, undamaged, and fully seated. Avoid bending the fiber sharply or pinching it under skirting boards.
