

# What fiber optic cable should be used for the SFP module

- Alternative Options:** For very short distances (up to 10 meters), Direct Attach Copper (DAC) cables or Active Optical Cables (AOC) can be used instead of traditional fiber, providing cost-effective and low-power connectivity.
