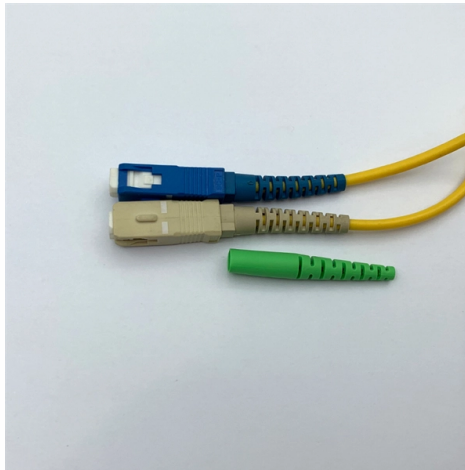


What is a suspension wire in an optical fiber cable line

The spacing between poles typically ranges from 25–50 meters in urban and suburban areas, with careful consideration of sag and elongation under load.
