

What is the minimum size for the incoming cable to a distribution box

Ensuring adequate box fill prevents overheating and maintains compliance with NEC 314.16.

Installation Practices Leave extra cable length for future maintenance or modifications. Avoid sharp bends; follow the minimum bending radius recommended for the cable type. Ensure the cable is properly supported and secured outside the box to prevent strain on connections. For outdoor or wet locations, use weatherproof boxes and cables with appropriate insulation.
