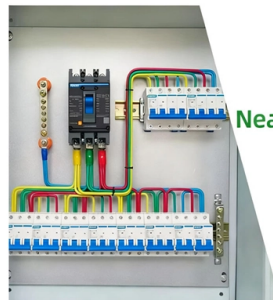

Fixed supports should also be placed at the beginning and end of the tray and at beam locations to distribute weight effectively. Vertical Cable Tray Runs For vertical installations, supports should be fixed to the building structure at intervals preferably less than 2 meters. Cables within vertical trays should be secured at the top and then every 1.5 meters to maintain order and prevent displacement. Hanging rod supports for vertical runs should have a minimum diameter of 8 mm to ensure stability. Cable Hangers and Flexible Systems When using cable hangers or J-hanger installations, the spacing may vary depending on the cable type, weight, and stiffness. Flexible systems require calculations to determine the distance between supports to achieve a small deflection (typically 2%) and prevent expansion or displacement due to thermal effects. Stiffer cables, such as MDPE-sheathed types, may require greater spacing between supports compared to more flexible cables like LSOH types. Best Practices Always secure cables at start, end, and turns of horizontal runs, and at top and intervals in vertical runs. Avoid cable crossings or overlaps within trays to main...
