4. Power On Devices in Sequence First, plug in and power on the ONT. Wait a few minutes for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network. Next, power on your router and wait for it to establish a connection with the ONT.
5. Verify the Connection Check the ONT lights: a solid green or blue PON/Optical light indicates a successful fiber link. Confirm your router's internet connection by connecting a device via Wi-Fi or Ethernet and running a speed test.

Precautions Ensure the fiber cable is not bent sharply or damaged. Keep connectors clean and avoid touching the fiber tip. Place both ONT and router near power outlets and in a dry, ventilated area. By following these steps, your fiber optic connection will be properly routed through the ONT to your router, providing stable high-speed internet.
