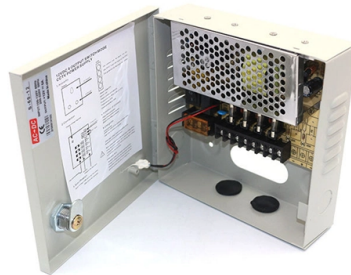

Most pigtail catheters are placed in the mid-axillary line, in the 4th to 6th intercostal space and at the same level as the nipple.
