- 5. Wiring Branch Circuits:** Connect each outgoing circuit wire to its corresponding breaker. Use appropriate wire sizes: 2.5mm^2 for lighting and sockets, 4mm^2 for high-power appliances. Maintain proper wire color coding: phase wires (yellow, green, red for A, B, C phases), neutral (blue), and ground (green/yellow).
- 6. Organizing Wires:** Route wiring neatly: main circuit connections on the left, outgoing circuits on the right. Bind wires with plastic ties at uniform spacing to prevent tangling and ensure neatness.
- 7. Labeling and Marking:** Clearly mark each circuit and voltage level (AC/DC) for easy identification and maintenance.
- 8. Testing and Inspection:** Use a multimeter to verify all connections.
