

# Where to plug the fiber optic transceiver and network cable into the switch

**Step 3: Insert the Transceiver** Align the transceiver with the SFP slot, ensuring the metal connectors match the port orientation. Gently slide the transceiver into the slot until it clicks into place. Some transceivers have a pull tab or bail latch to secure them. For 16 Gbps SFP+ modules, it is recommended to connect the fiber cable first and then insert the transceiver as a unit.

**Step 4: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable** Plug the fiber optic cable into the transceiver, matching the TX and RX strands correctly between devices (A to B, B to A). Avoid bending the fiber sharply or touching the exposed fiber ends to prevent damage.

**Step 5: Power On and Verify** Turn on the switch if it was powered off during installation. Check the LED indicators on the transceiver; a green light usually indicates a successful connection. If the port shows errors or does not link, verify transceiver compatibility, fiber type, and cable orientation. By following these steps, you ensure a secure and functional connection between your fiber opti...
