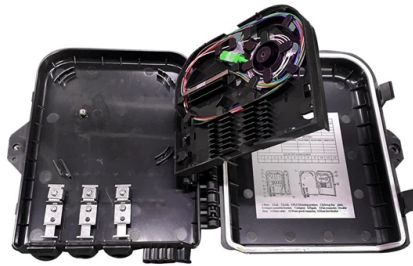


Which light is on the router when the fiber optic cable is plugged in
