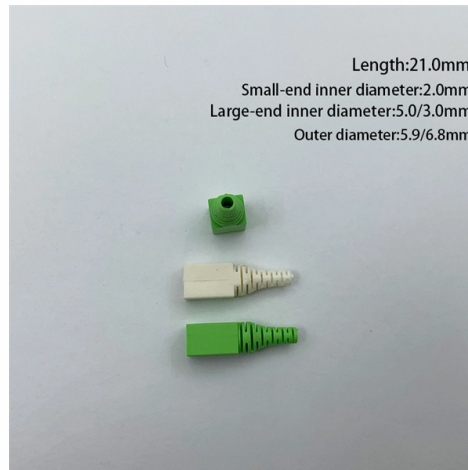


Which switches should be installed in the distribution box
