The switch must be connected to the hot wire to control the light properly. Potential Issues Even if the switch is connected, the light may not turn on if: The switch interrupts the neutral wire instead of the hot wire, leaving the fixture live but not illuminating the bulb, which is dangerous. The switch is faulty or worn out, failing to break or complete the circuit. The bulb is burned out or the fixture has a wiring fault. Safety Tips Always turn off the circuit breaker before connecting or inspecting a switch. Use a voltage tester to confirm the power is off before touching wires. Properly connecting the switch to the hot wire ensures the light will illuminate safely when the switch is turned on.
