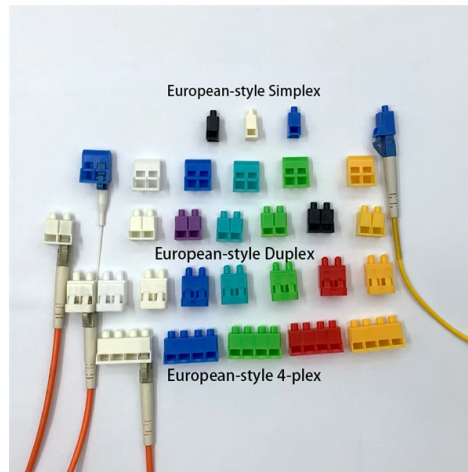


Wiring between fan distribution box and control box



AI Overview

Proper wiring of a fan distribution box ensures safe operation, correct fan function, and compliance with electrical codes. **Safety First** Before starting, turn off the circuit breaker supplying the fan and verify that the wires are de-energized using a non-contact voltage tester. This prevents accidental shock. Always follow local electrical codes and, if unsure, consult a licensed electrician.

Required Components

- Fan-rated electrical box:** Must support the fan's weight (typically at least 35–50 lbs) and vibration.
- Wires:** Standard 120V circuits use 14/2 NM-B cable (hot, neutral, ground) for single control, or 14/3 if separate fan and light control is needed.
- Switches:** Single-pole, pull-chain, or timer switches depending on control preference.
- Wire nuts and electrical tape:** For secure connections.

Wiring Connections

- Line (Hot) wire:** Usually black, carries current from the breaker to the switch or fan.
- Load wire:** Also black or red, carries switched current from the switch to the fan motor or light fixture.
- Neutral wire:** White, completes the circuit back to the panel; do not connect to switch terminals.
- Ground wire:** Bare copper or green, connects to the metal box and fan grounding screw to prevent shock.

Step-by-Step Wiring

- Mount the fan-rated box** securely to a ceiling joist or support brace.
- Strip wire ends** about ½ inch and organize wires inside the box.
- Connect wires:**
 - Black (line) to black fan lead
 - White (neutral) to white fan lead
 - Green/bare (ground) to fan grounding screw and metal box
- Use wire nuts and wrap connections with electrical tape for extra security.
- Push wires carefully into the box, ensuring no bare copper is exposed.
- Attach fan mounting bracket and secure the fan according to manufacturer instructions.

Circuit Considerations

Most ceiling fans draw 1–2 amps; ensure the circuit can handle the load without exceeding 15A. For long wire runs, consider voltage drop; upsize wire if necessary to maintain...

Distribution Box Wiring Steps

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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Insure that no bare wires can come into contact with live electrical parts and that wire cannot be pinched between the control box sides and lid. Insert the strain relief into the control box entry hole to secure
