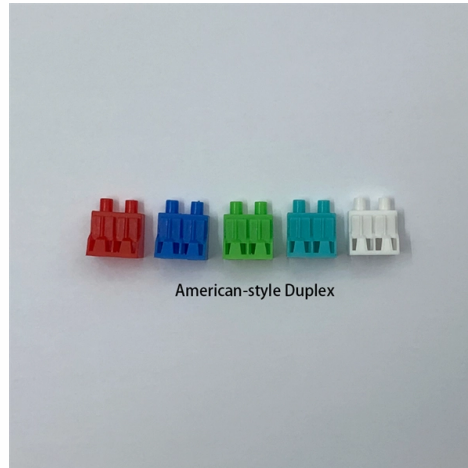


Wiring markings for equipment distribution box
