

Wiring method for 8 household distribution boxes

Overview of Household Distribution Box Wiring

A distribution box (DB) is used to safely distribute electrical power from the main supply to multiple subcircuits in a home. For 8 distribution boxes, each box will typically include:

- Main isolator or double-pole MCB:** Acts as the main switch to manually disconnect the supply.
- RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker):** Protects against leakage currents and electric shocks.
- Single-pole MCBs:** Protect individual circuits from overload or short circuits.
- Neutral and Earth busbars:** Ensure proper return paths and grounding for safety.

Step-by-Step Wiring Method

Incoming Supply Connection Connect the phase (live) and neutral from the energy meter to the main isolator in each distribution box. Ensure the main isolator rating matches the total load of the box (commonly 63A for domestic use).

RCCB Installation Connect the output of the main isolator to the RCCB. The RCCB's phase input comes from the isolator, and the neutral input is connected to the neutral busbar. Choose an RCCB with a 30mA sensitivity for domestic protection.

MCB Connections Connect the phase output from the RCCB to the MCBs in parallel. Each MCB protects a specific subcircuit (e.g., lighting, sockets, kitchen appliances). The neutral of each subcircuit is connected to the neutral busbar.

Neutral and Earth Busbars All neutral wires from subcircuits connect to the neutral busbar, which is linked to the RCCB neutral. All earth wires connect to the earth busbar, which is bonded to the building's grounding system.

Load Distribution Across 8 Boxes Distribute circuits logically to balance the load across all 8 boxes. For example, assign lighting and small appliances to some boxes, and high-power appli...
