

Wiring method for Level 2 electrical distribution box on construction site

Connections: Connect incoming power to the main breaker, then route wires to branch breakers. Ensure line-to-line, neutral-to-neutral, and ground-to-ground connections are correct. Use parallel connections if needed to simplify wiring.

Cable Management: Route wires neatly, secure with plastic ties at uniform spacing, and leave space for heat dissipation. Avoid sharp edges and tangling.

Grounding and Bonding: Connect all metallic parts to a bonding conductor to ensure electrical continuity and safety. Proper earthing is critical for construction site safety.
