

Wiring of the cabinet

Running electrical wiring inside cabinets requires careful planning, adherence to safety codes, and proper routing to ensure both functionality and aesthetics. Planning and Safety Considerations Before starting, assess your electrical needs, including appliances, under-cabinet lighting, and accent lighting. High-voltage wiring (120V) must comply with the National Electrical Code (NEC), including the use of accessible junction boxes for all splices and connections. Junction boxes should be flush with the cabinet interior and covered with removable plates to allow future maintenance without removing cabinet structures. Always use proper safety gear, including insulated gloves and voltage testers, and ensure power is off before handling wires. High-Voltage Wiring For appliances like microwaves or coffee stations, dedicated 120V outlets can be installed inside cabinets. Use NM-B (Romex) cable, secured with clamps, and protect wires from sharp edges when passing through drilled holes in cabinet stiles or rails. Route wires along the back corners of cabinets to keep them out of sight and prevent damage from stored items. Flexible metal conduit (FMC) can also be used to protect NM-B cables in exposed areas. Low-Voltage Wiring Low-voltage wiring, such as for LED under-cabinet lighting, is thinner and more flexible, making it easier to conceal along cabinet edges or behind face frames. Use adhesive-backed wire channels or raceways to create a neat, protected path. Power supplies or drivers should be mounted in accessible locations inside the cabinet, with proper strain relief where high-voltage wiring connects to the driver. Routing Between Cabinets When moving wiring between adjacent cabinets, drill pilot holes through stiles or rails, just large enough for the wire. Ensure wires are centered and protected from abrasion. Secure wires with insulated staples along the cabinet interior to maintain a clean and safe installation. Additional Tips Label all wires for future reference and maintenance. Plan circuits carefully: one outlet per 4 feet of countertop...
