Step 3: Choose the Circuit Protection Use a single-pole MCB for the fan circuit if it's a standard load, or a double-pole MCB if controlling both live and neutral. An RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) is recommended to protect against leakage currents and electrical shocks.

Step 4: Wiring Connections From the distribution box to the fan room, run a cable with sufficient cross-sectional area to handle the fan load (typically 1.5–2.5 mm² for a single fan in domestic wiring). Connect the live wire from the MCB output to the fan's live input. Connect the neutral wire from the neutral bus bar in the distribution box to the fan's neutral wire. Connect the ground wire from the earth bus bar to the fan's ground terminal. If the fan has a light, use a separate live wire (often blue) for the light circuit, connecting it to a dedicated switch if required.

Step 5: Testing After all connections are made, turn on the main breaker and test the fan operation. Ensure the fan and light (if applicable) operate correctly and that the MCB trips under fault conditions. Double-check all wire nuts and connections for tightness and insulation.
