

Wiring steps for distribution box switches

Double-pole MCBs: connect both phase and neutral from the RCCB output to the MCB input for special loads. Connect the load terminals of each MCB to the respective devices, ensuring the earth wire is connected to the earth bar.
- 3. Wiring Direction and Management**
Main circuit wiring generally runs on the left side of the distribution box; outgoing branch circuits on the right side. Use plastic ties to bind wires neatly, maintaining uniform spacing and straight runs to prevent tangling or overheating. Clearly mark AC/DC and voltage levels for each circuit to avoid confusion during maintenance.
- 4. Grounding and Safety**
Ensure all earth wires are securely connected to the earth bar. Verify neutral and earth separation to prevent short circuits. Use properly rated conductors and follow torque specifications for all terminals. Avoid loose connections, jumper wires, or incorrect pole configurations, as these can cause overheating or equipment failure.
- 5. Final Checks and Testing**
Perform visual inspection to confirm correct connections and neat wiring. Test insulation resistance and circuit continuity using a multimeter. Ensure all...
